How to get there

Venue: Muzeum Śląskie, ul. T. Dobrowolskiego 1, 40-205 Katowice, Poland

How to get to Katowice city centre

If you arrive at the Katowice Airport (Pyrzowice)

Public transport - bus

- direct line "Lotnisko Pyrzowice/ Pyrzowice Airport" operates between the city centre and the airport (the trip lasts approx. 50 minutes)

- the bus stops - on demand - at the Novotel, Qubus and Angelo hotels and terminates at the railway station right in the city centre

- tickets available <u>online</u> and on board (cash only) price: 27 zł

Other options

- mini-bus option - direct lines to Katowice from the airport, booking in advance possible (see details on the airport website (<u>http://www.katowice-airport.com/en/passengers/access</u>)

- taxi services - the taxi rank is situated in front of Terminals A and B, the Airport taxi service office is located on the ground floor in the Terminal B (<u>http://www.taxipyrzowice.pl</u>, <u>http://echotaxi.com.pl/cennikEN.php</u>)

- car rental offices are located on the ground floor in the Terminals A and B (http://www.katowice-airport.com/en/passengers/rent-a-car)

If you arrive at the Kraków Airport (Balice)

Private buses

- direct lines to Katowice from the airport, booking in advance possible (see details on the websites <u>http://www.tigerexpress.eu/pl/</u>, <u>http://neobus.pl/</u> and <u>http://www.albatrosbus.pl/</u>). You can reach Katowice in less than 1 hour for less than 30 zł

Public transport

There is no direct connection between the Kraków Airport and the Katowice city centre by public means of transport. One should take **a bus**

(http://www.krakowairport.pl/en/passenger,c70/transport-parking,c76/how-to-get-to-krakowairport,c77/train,a1756.html) to the main Railway Station in Kraków (Kraków Główny) and then change to bus to Katowice (buses leave every 15 min). It takes abour 1:30h to reach Katowice from Kraków city centre.




If you arrive at Katowice city centre

- By rail: The Silesian Museum is just 2 km from Katowice train station. The venue can be reached by walk in about 20 min. Alternatively, the bus 940 takes roughly 10 minutes to reach the venue. More information on this option can be found at bus timetable website.

- By coach: On arrival, the easiest way to get to the venue is to walk. It takes about 15 min. Alternatively, you can walk to train station (5 min) and take a bus 940.

- By car: The venue is located near a popular domestic road Warsaw - Częstochowa - Katowice - Bielsko-Biała. The Silesian Museum has a parking. Ground parking is free of charge. Underground parking is free of charge up to 6 hours if the parking ticket is validated in the Museum `s box office. Every additional hour is charged 5 zł.



Where to stay

You can easily find suitable accommodation in Katowice. Ibis Budget Hotel, Novotel Katowice Centrum, Hotel Diament Spodek Katowice and Qubus Hotel Prestige are just a short walk from the venue. There is also Hotel Angelo just opposite coach station.

Travel and accommodation are arranged and paid by the participants.

What to see

The venue is in the vicinity of the new seat of the Polish Radio National Symphony Orchestra, which is believed to be among the best concert halls worldwide. The Silesian Museum is open from 10 to 20 and on Tuesdays the entrance is free of charge. Katowice and the neighbouring towns offer also other tourist attractions, including the sites associated with the region's industrial heritage.
