<b>The first call</b> (5 April – 31 May 2022)	
<b>134</b>	project proposals
<b>780</b>	organisations from all Partner States
<b>EUR 1.4 million</b>	average ERDF budget per project proposal
<b>EUR 98 million</b>	ERDF budget committed

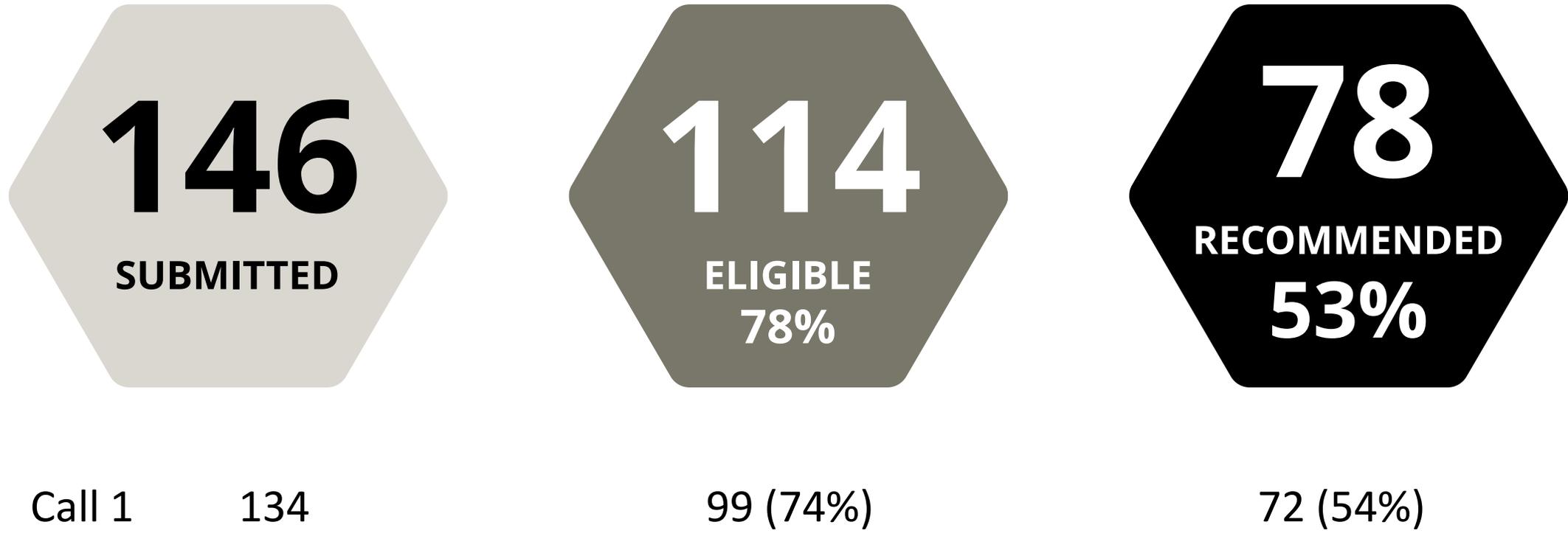

<b>The second call</b> (15 March - 9 June 2023)

<b>EUR 108 million</b>	ERDF budget committed

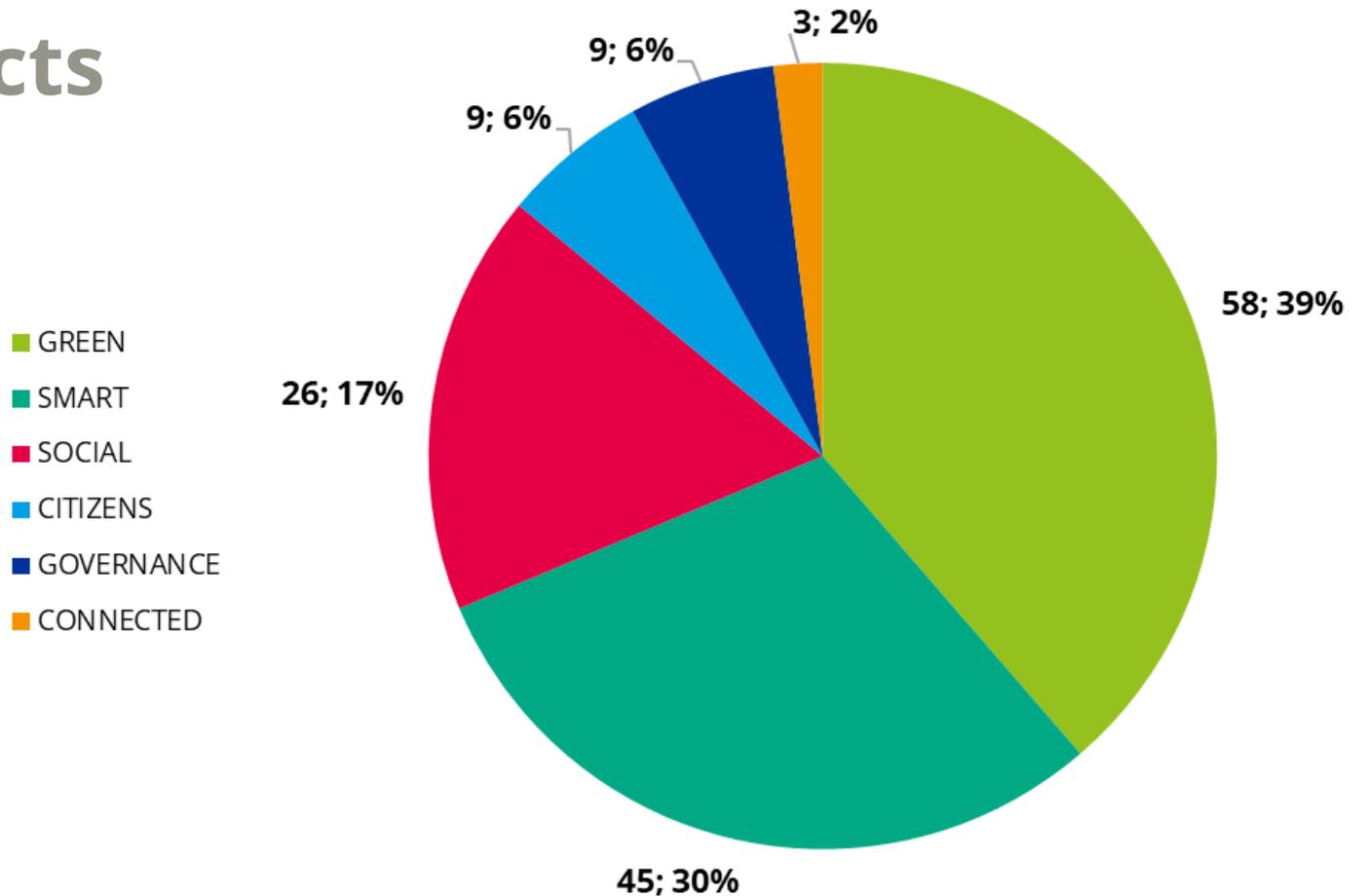

# Call 2 **success rate**

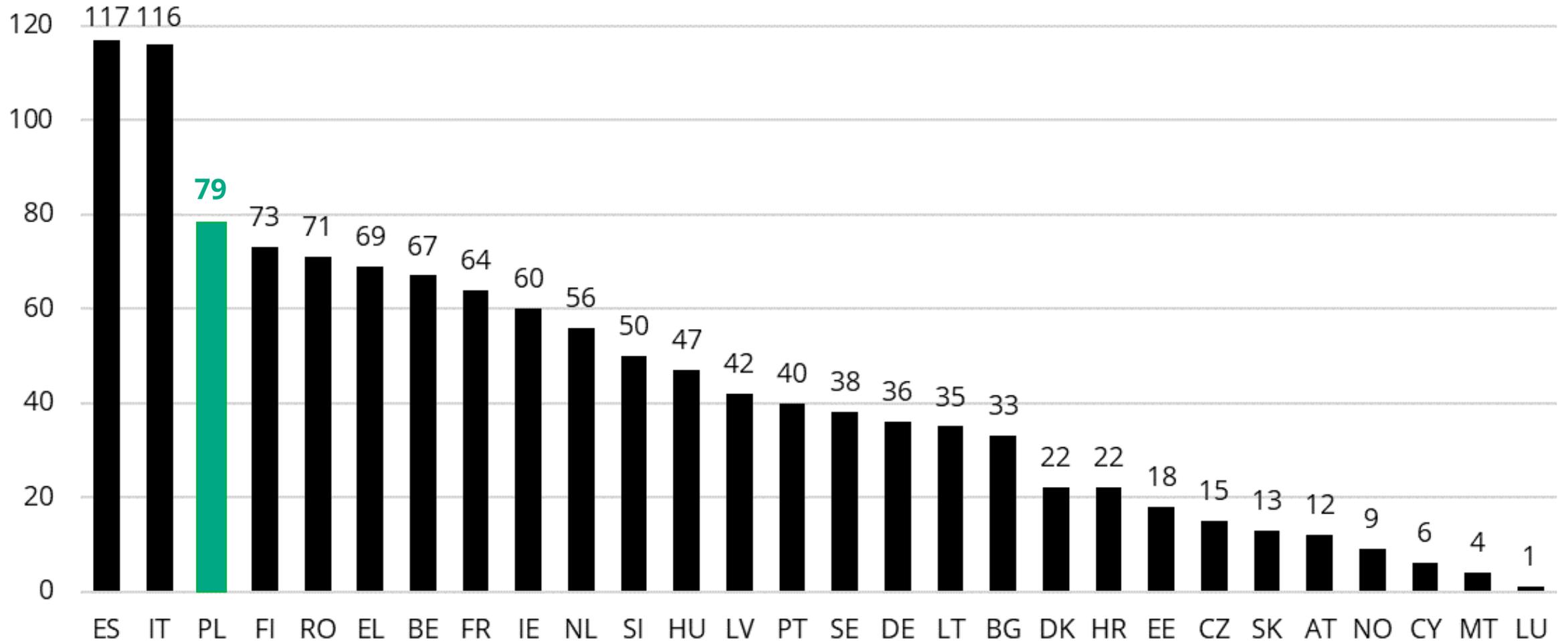


# Overview of projects approved so far

# First and second call - **lessons learned**

## **On eligibility**

- Ensure that at least one instrument is an **Investment for growth & jobs** goal programme
- Check carefully the **'policy responsible authority' status** of the organisations involved in the project
- Don't prepare documents (e.g., declarations) at the last minute

# First and second call - **lessons learned**

## **On quality assessment**

- **Partnership** is key
  - Broad geographical area (e.g., AL, BA, BG, ME, MK, SI and part of FR also in MED)
  - Balanced partnership (e.g., country representation, mix between more & less advanced regions)
  - Policy relevance of partners
- Quality of **results**
  - Innovative character (especially when partners who come back on similar topic)
  - Expected policy improvements
