(1) We want you to exploit promising outputs and results!

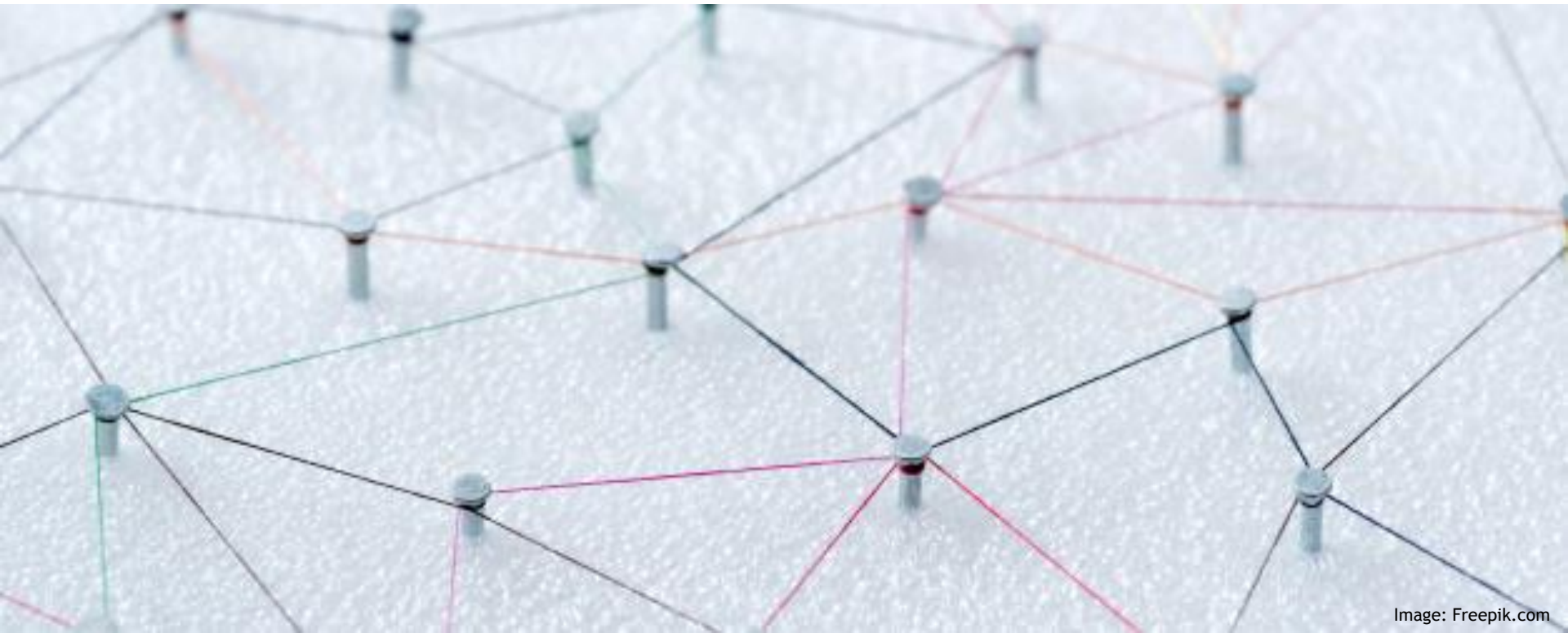
Exploitation is any action that makes use of promising outputs and results already achieved by previously funded projects in the concerned central European regions.

Exploitation goes beyond a mere duplication of existing outputs and results. They shall be further developed and tailored to the needs of the regions and target groups.

Results can be **upstreamed** for better policymaking



...and **downstreamed** for broader impacts in our area



(2) We want you to burst the Interreg bubble and coordinate forces!

Coordination is about joining forces and mobilising a critical mass that can effectively influence policies or better roll out results at the regional and local levels.

New projects have to combine knowledge, to increase outreach, visibility and political attention as well as to improve existing networks.

You will have to create synergies and add value beyond what was already achieved.

Minimum requirements for project proposals

REQUIREMENT





Thematic focus ■ Focus of the proposal on one of the 7 pre-selected topics

Coordination ■ At least 2 Interreg CE projects of calls 1 and 2 (44 projects referring to the 7 topics)
■ At least one thematically relevant project funded by a directly-managed EU programme

Partnership ■ At least 50 % of the partnership from the Interreg CE projects of calls 1 and 2 whose outputs and results are going to be exploited
■ At least one partner from each project funded by directly-managed EU programmes whose outputs and results are going to be exploited

Multiple participation ■ A same institution/body cannot be involved in more than one proposal within a same topic

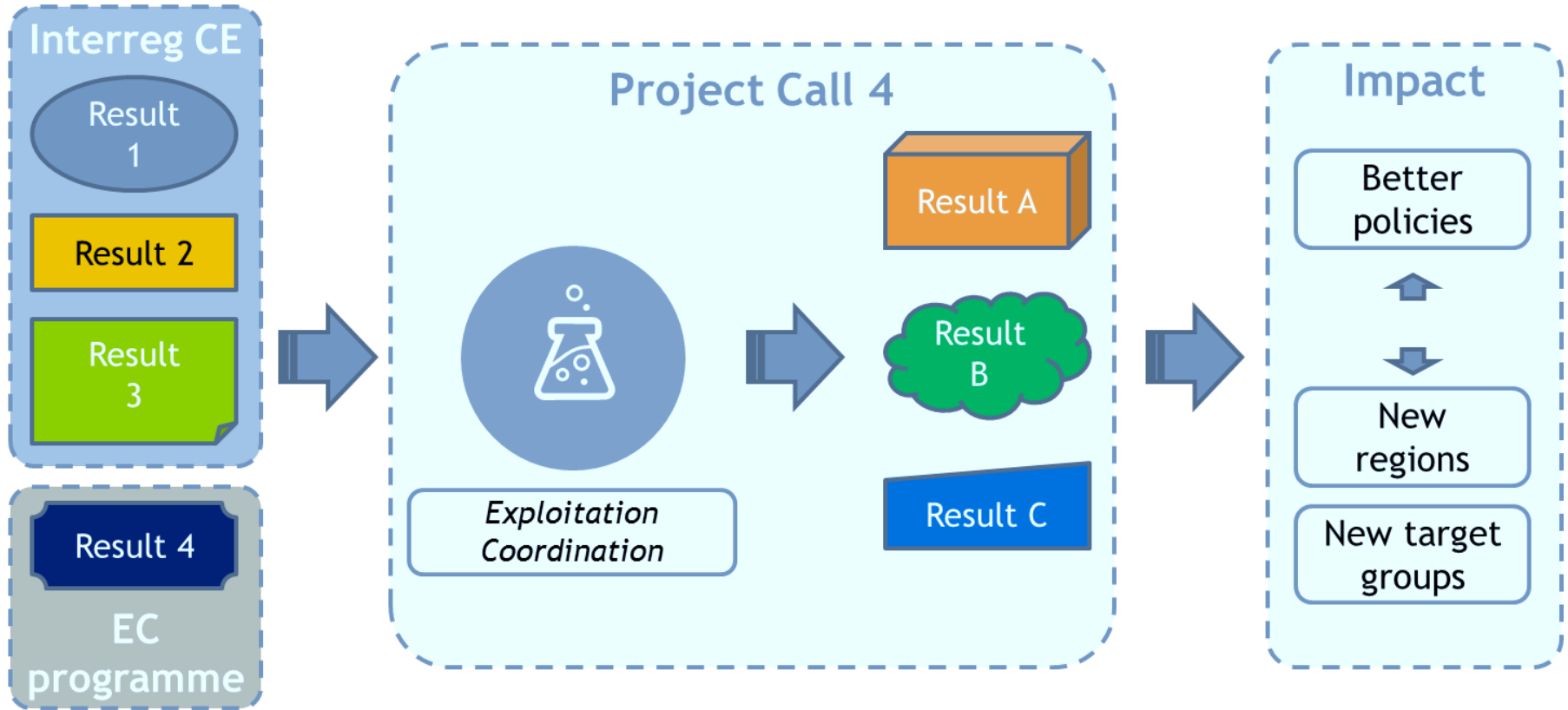

Key project features

- Limited **preparatory activities** (studies or analyses)
- Focus on the implementation of **tools and pilot actions** (downstreaming) or of **strategies and action plans** (upstreaming)
- **Communication activities** contribute to the exploitation but shall not be the main focus of a proposal
- **Number of partners** and **budget size** shall reflect the scope of the project → no recommendations
- Maximum duration of **24 months**

Exploitation and coordination in practice
